
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



Antigua 54" Linear

WE RECOMMEND INSTALLATION OF THIS LIGHTING FIXTURE BE DONE BY A LICENSED ELECTRICIAN.

WARNING***SWITCH OFF THE MAIN ELECTRICAL SUPPLY FROM THE MAIN FUSE BOX/CIRCUIT BREAKER BEFORE INSTALLATION.

INSPECT ITEM CAREFULLY BEFORE ATTEMPTING TO INSTALL.

IF THERE IS ANY DAMAGE OR OBVIOUS DEFECT. DO NOT INSTALL.

ITEM MAY NOT BE RETURNED ONCE IT HAS BEEN INSTALLED.


NOTE: CAREFULLY UNPACK EACH PIECE IN TOP LAYER OF PACKING PRIOR TO REMOVING. RETAIN ALL PACKING MATERIAL UNTIL INSPECTION AND **INSTALLATION ARE FINAL.**

- 1. Carefully remove all parts from the box. Place on a clean, soft surface.
- 2. Using the mounting plate (B) as a guide, line up with the junction box and mark anchor positions.
- 3. Using a drill bit slightly smaller than the anchor, drill holes in the marked positions. Install anchors (J) into the holes using a hammer.
- 4. Install mounting plate (B) to the junction box and secure with mounting screws (C), then secure wood screws (K) to anchors (J).
- 5. Secure collar loops (D) to mouting plate (B) using pliers to tighten locknut.
- 6. Install canopy (E) to collar loops (D) and secure with collar rings (F).
- 7. Determine desired overall length, and amount of chains (H) needed. Shorten chain using chain pliers. (Keep extra chain)
- 8. Attach chains (H) to collar loops (D) and fixture loops (I) using quick links (G). Secure quick links (G).
- 9. Thread fixture wire and ground wire through chains (H). **NOTE:** When you reach the collar loop **(D)**, ensure there is no tension on the wires. Cut excess wires, being sure to leave enough to reach the junction box.
- 10. Separate two sides of molded wire, and strip insulation on each 5/8".
- 11. Loosen collar rings (F) and let canopy (E) slip down chains (H) carefully.





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12. Twist all fixture wires together. Slip through center hole of collar loop (D).

NOTE: Untwist wires and separate to prepare for connection.

- 13. Wrap fixture ground wire (bare copper) around the green grounding screw (see diagram 1). Tighten. Continue fixture ground wire and connect to supply ground wire (usually green or bare copper) using wire nut (A).
 - NOTE: It is imperative that the fixture is grounded.
- 14. Connect fixture neutral wire (ribbed) to the supply neutral wire (usually white) using wire nut (A).
- 15. Connect fixture hot wire (smooth with markings) to the supply hot wire (usually black) using wire nut (A).
 - **CAUTION:** Do not reverse the hot and neutral connections.
- 16. Make sure all wire connections are tight, then carefully tuck into the junction box.
- 17. Install canopy (E) to mounting plate (B) and secure with collar rings (F).
- 18. Install light bulbs into the sockets.
- 19. Installation is complete.
- * * * Clean with a dry, soft cloth only. Do not use harsh abrasives or chemical agents.
